

## Mr. KWA ENG LEE.

Mr. Kwa Eng Leo is a native of Chaoyang District, Kwangtung Province, born in 1886.

He obtained his education at the Y. M. C. A., Day School, Hongkong, and after he was graduated, he began to practise business in the Colony. He established the Swatow Lace Company in Hongkong with the main destination to promote the Chinese drawn work and embroideries, which are highly recommanded in the Western Countries. His able management enables him to further his business to such an extend that to-day there are branches of his company in Swatow and Pieping.

Besides his commercial activities, Mr. Kwa has been devoting a lot of his time and interest in dealing public weal. He has been appointed by His Late Excellency Dr. Sun Yat Sen as a committee in the management of the affairs of the Chaochow and Mei-hsien Districts. In 1928, he was appointed representative for the Chinese Chamber of Commerce Manila P. I. in the Carnival Exhibition of the Philippine Islands. He is one of the founders of the Chinese Bathing Club and a patron of the Chinese Swimming Club, Hongkong. In 1920, he established the Chin Tack School in his native village and contributes to it a yearly fund.

He is a faithful Christian and is one of the original members of the Chaochow Chinese Christian Association, Hongkong Branch.

Married in 1905, Mr. Kwa has two sons and four daughters. All of them have received a thorough education.
