

Mr. M. H. Lo is one of the commanding figures in the commercial sphere of Hong Kong.

A native of the Kwangtung Province, and born in 1896, Mr. Lo is a member of a very well known Chinese family in Hongkong, his father being the late Mr. Lo Cheung Shiu, J.P., a prominent and well respected resident.

Mr. Lo was educated at Queen's College and in 1915 entered the commercial Course of the Hongkong University, and left in 1918.

In 1934 Mr. Lo was appointed Compradore of the Princely Hong of Jardine Matheson and Company, Limited. His experience, conscientiousness and natural ability are valuable assets to the firm, whilst his transparent honesty and integrity, and innate courtesy endear him to all his business associates and friends. He is a member of the Committee of the Chinese General Chamber of Commerce and the Sports Club, Director of the Hongkong Engineering and Construction Co., Ltd., and Chairman of the Compradore Association. He was appointed a Justice of the Peace in 1936.
