

Professor HSU TI SHAN, B.A., M.A.

Professor Hsu is a native of Lung-ki District, Fukien Province, where he was born in 1894. He procured his education in the Yenking University. After he obtained the B. A. degree from that institute he continued his studies in the Columbia University, N.Y., U.S.A., where he obtained the M. A. degree. Then he was transferred to the Oxford University, England, and again attained the B. A. degree:

Since he returned to China, he was appointed at different times as professor in the Yenking University; the Peking University; and the Ching IIwa University. In 1936 he was appointed by the Hongkong University to be the dean of the Department of Chinese Literature.

Professor II su has written many books regarding Chinese literature, and besides, he is an expert in Mandarin language. He was a member of the Preparatory Committee of Unification of Chinese Dialects in the Board of Education; and a member of the Post Graduate Institute Peking.
