Mr. Wong Yan Ching was born in Ko Iu District of Kwangtung province in 1892. He was first educated in the King's College Hongkong and then in the Queen's College. Later he was transferred to study in the Kwangtung Provincial Higher Normal College, Canton. After graduation he was for some time the compradore of a foreign firm Hongkong.

As he was a faithful follower of the late Dr. Sun Yat Sen, he made great efford in forming the Republic of China. He was either chief editor or associated editor at different times of the various Newspapers in Canton or in the Colony.

Besides being a well known journalist Mr. Wong is also an enthusiastic educator. He has been a teaching staff of many famous schools in this Island. About a decade ago he founded a girls' school in Kaingmoon and later he founded the Kwong Wah Middle school, the Kwang Wah elemantary school and the Kwang Wah Girls' school. He is now the principal of these schools.

He is noted for his activities in social and charitable affairs. He is member of the Committee of the Kowloon Chinese Educational Association and of the Chung Sing Benevolent Association. He has written many Novels which are so interest and are welcome by most of the young people, so he is also called as a Novelist.

The readers of his humourous novels may easily think that Mr. Wong must be a very funny man; but, on the contrary, he is a man of dignified appearance. He talks very little yet works very much. His sincerity and honesty endear him to all the people with whom he associates.

During the beginning of the establishment of the Republic of China most of the journalists of the Kuomintang, the national party, were appointed as officials in the Government; but Mr. Wong declined all the posts offerred to him. He does not mind very much about wealth and fame, but he likes literary works and teaching best.
