

Dr. Ho Tin Sang, one of the outstanding physicians in Kowloon and Hongkong, is a native of Wai-yang District, Kwangtung Province, but was born in Dutch Guiana, Surinam, in 1894.

His ancestors had long been living in that country and his father was one of the prominent Chinese merchants there. Dr. Ho studied medicine in Holland and when he had passed the Medical Course he proceeded to Scotland and continued his studies in the University of Edinburgh where he attained the L.R.C.P. & S. degree in 1922. He can speak five kinds of language of different countries.

At the end in 1922, he returned to Hongkong and put up his own practice. His experience and skill have given remedy to many fatal diseases and thus won a good reputation in the Colony.

Dr. Ho married in 1925 to Wong Chi Kin, who was graduated in Chile, South America. They have six children and except those who are still young the others are educated in local schools.
