

One of the most famous physicians and surgeons in Hongkong is Dr. Tso Ta Ming. He is a native of Nan-hai District, Kwangtung Province and was born in 1906. He pursued his early education in the Ling Nam University, Canton, and after he graduated he continued his studies in the University of Edicburgh, Scotland, where he passed his Medical Course with the M.B., CH.B. degrees with Honours, and the M.D. degree.

Dr. Tso procured his D.M.R.E. degree from the University of Liverpool, England.

Dr. Tso has been putting on his own practice since he returned to the Colony and not long ago, he has established the Tso's Clinic where he is co-operating with his brother.

Dr. Tso was president of Kwang Wah Medical College, Canton; professor of Surgery and Radiology of Kwang Wah Medical School, Canton; and superintendent of Kwang Wah Hospital, Canton. He is a member of the Committee in Tuberculosis, Chinese Medical Association. In 1930, Dr. Tso was contributing editor of the British Journal of Physiology in England.

Married in 1932 to Lau Mong Ha who is a graduate of Pui To Girls' School, Canton. They have a boy whose name is Tso Wai Hung and is four years of age.
