李先生景康。字鳳坡。東粵南海人。現年四十五。學貫中西。才名籍甚。誠我國富有學問之教育家也。幼在阿里松溪鄉私塾肄業。旋負笈香港聖士提反中學。民國元年。考獲英國牛津大學高等試文憑。中文特著優異。其時香港大學創辦伊始。乃政文科。民國四年。以第一屆



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○本港政府初辦之請。亟思提倡我國國學。遂有官立漢文中學之創設。教育司另因胡先生長之。並使主官立漢文師範學校事。綿歷十載。以迄於茲。能猶猶善。沾沾士林。故本港與吾學執教者。多出其門。聲譽於焉益著。先生凡遇教育設施。與社團職務。尤樂勤厥事。勉為其難。如民十三。在粵。被選為廣東全省教育會幹事。及廣東廣州南海中學校長。創辦南海石門中學校。倡建港大馬路山圖書館。倡建香港孔聖堂幹事。值理。僑港南海商會董事。創辦港大中文學院起草委員。港大中文學會名譽會員。港大歷屆考試委員。皆其尤著者也。先生擅詩文。工繪事。被徵為江蘇常熟虞社社員。湖南長沙南社湘集社員。江蘇吳縣中國學會會員。香港士中書畫合作社幹事。值理。居恒潛心國學。著述甚富。嘗著披雲樓詩草。七言律法舉隅。及與區大典岑光樸兩太史陳煜序進士等合編國文模範讀本三冊。與張谷維君合編陽羨砂壩圖考。葉公譽為之作序。多藝多才。不愧嶺南名士也。先生原配鄒夫人。詩款。早卒。繼室蘇夫人。名蓮寶。上海啓明女中學學生。男公子六。曰尚毅。尚勇。鄒秉中學。尚治。尚沛。尚平。鄒秉小學。尚信。未屆學齡。女公子四。曰綺林。已婚。綺仙。綺樓。均就小學。綺嫻。則尚幼焉。

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## Mr. K. H. LI, B.A.

Mr. Li is a native of Nan - hai District, Kwangtung Province, and was born in 1892. He received his early education from a private school of his native village, and later entered St. Stephen's College, Hongkong, where in 1912 he passed the Oxford Senior Local Examination with distinction in Chinese and the first Hongkong University Matriculation Examination. Thereupon he took an Arts course at the local University and graduated in 1916 with a B.A. degree. In 1917 when General Ju Hing Lan was Civil Governor of Kwangtung, the Bureau of Provincial Protection was established and Mr. Li was appointed a councillor of this institution. Mr. Li returned to Hongkong in the following year on being offered a teaching post by St. Stephen's College, his alma mater. He held this post until 1922 when he was appointed Headmaster of the Nan - hai Middle School and the Nan - hai Normal School, Canton, on the recommendation of the gentry and the Chamber of Commerce of his native district. Appointed Inspector of vernacular Schools and English Private Schools by the Education Department in 1924, he returned to the Colony for a second time. In two years he was transferred to the Headmastership of the Government Vernacular Middle School, and that of the Government Normal School, the former institution was founded in 1926 and the latter in 1921. Mr. Li is a man of broad sympathy and every good cause finds him a willing supporter. In recognition of his success in educational work he was elected a member of the Advisory Committee of the Kwangtung Provincial Education Association in 1924 before he came back to Hongkong in that year. The various social services he has rendered in Canton and Hongkong may be well signified by the following elections and appointments. He has served as member of the school council of the Nan - hai Middle School, Shik Moon Middle School, Canton, Executive Committee of the Confucius Hall; Hon. member of the Chinese Association of the Hongkong University, and Hon. Treasurer of the Hongkong University Graduates' Association, Hongkong. In 1928 he was called upon together with Dr. Au Tai Tin and Dr. Lai Chai Hsi to draft the scheme and syllabus for the establishment of the Chinese School of the local University, and has served as member of its Board of Examination. Mr. Li is an adept of Chinese literature and pictorial art. He is a member of the U - Shia Literary Association at Chang-Hsu, Kiangsu Province; member of the Nan - Shia Literary Association at Changsha, Hunan Province; and member of the China National Learning Association at Wu Hsien, Kiangsu Province the last two being the leading societies of men of letters in China. He has published three of his many literary works in Chinese, namely, the Pi Yun Lau Poems, a study of Seven - Word - Line Poems, and a set of three books entitled Model Readers on the Dictions and Styles of Chinese Essayists. For the last work he is a joint editor. Being a connoisseur of Chinese painting he was responsible for the organization of the Chinese Pictorial art Section of the China Exhibition held in the local City Hall in 1931. Mr. Li has six sons and four daughters; except those who are still young, the others are receiving their education in local schools.
