Mr. CHOY HING

The Chairman of the Board of Directors of both The Sun Company, Ltd., and the Sincere Co., Ltd., two of the well-known department stores in Hong Kong, Shanghai, and Canton, is Mr. Choy Hing. He is a native of Chung Shan District, Kwangtung Province, where he was born in 1869.

He obtained his early education in his native town, and later he proceeded to Shanghai and continued his studies in the Anglo-Chinese School there. After attaining a fair knowledge of both Chinese and English, he set out for Australia, to start a commercial career.

While in Australia, Mr. Choy went through many hardships, but eventually attained success in his line of business. He also interested himself in various philanthropic movements for the welfare of his compatriots.

Returning to Hong Kong in 1912, Mr. Choy founded The Sun Co., Ltd., with his brothers and a few friends, and later established branches of the Company in Canton and Shanghai. To-day The Sun Company, Ltd., shares the distinction with The Sincere Co., Ltd., and Wing On Co., Ltd., of being the three largest department stores in China.

Mr. Choy is a man of broad sympathy and every good cause finds him a willing supporter. He has held many important positions in China, and still holds, amongst others, the posts of Honorary Adviser to the Kwangtung Provincial Government and Honorary Adviser to the Chung Shan District Government.

In the Colony, Mr. Choy has been Vice-Chairman of Tung Wah Hospital, Member of Po Leung Kuk Committee and Member of District Watchmen's Committee. He is now a member of the Chinese Chamber of Commerce Executive Committee and Chairman and Director of numerous banks, companies and public institutions both in Hong Kong and China.

Mr. Choy has two sons. The elder is the Secretary of The Sun Co., Ltd., Hong Kong, while the younger is studying at St. John's University, Shanghai.
